

## **FRANK CRUMP, JR. NEXT GENERATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

**Deadline: March 31, 2021**

The Frank Crump Jr. Next Generation Scholarship was established to honor the legacy of Mr. Frank Crump, Jr., a distinguished mathematics educator, dedicated to furthering the educational growth and advancement of the “next generation.” A scholarship for \$1000 will be awarded to one African American high school senior. The scholarship is a one-time, non-renewable award that may be used to pay expenses for tuition, books and student fees. The award will be paid to and dispersed by the university.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

African-American high school seniors at Vicksburg High School and Warren Central High School with a 3.0 or higher GPA, enrolling full-time in a university, college, community college or vocational/trade school, majoring in engineering or other math-based majors.

### **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED**

- Completed application form and college acceptance letter (*if available*)
- Copy of official high school transcript
- Copy of ACT or SAT scores
- 2 signed letters of recommendation
- Essay written in first person, that includes an original, personal biographical statement, your education goals and career ambitions (*Minimum 2 pages, double-spaced, 12 point font, 1” margins*)

### **ABOUT THE ESSAY**

The essay is your original, personal statement that lets the review committee get to know you. Talk about your interests, education goals and career ambitions. Share experiences, ideas or events that shaped your interests. The essay should provide evidence of your achievements that is not reflected elsewhere in the application.

Mr. Frank Crump, Jr.’s mantra was that “each generation should do better than the one before”. Your essay should state how your educational goals, career ambitions and personal characteristics (i.e. integrity, compassion, persistence, etc.) will enable you to do better than the last generation and improve your prospects for success. How will you make a difference for your generation? What will you contribute?

Applications and all required documents must be submitted **no later than March 31, 2021**.
